The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner has preferred this petition for the issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 to 8.

Petitioner is the wife of respondent No.4. She has alleged some allegations due to matrimonial discord. The complaint was filed on 02.06.2020 before the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural and the same was entrusted to Police Station, Women Cell, Amritsar Rural on 09.06.2020.

Learned State counsel submitted that an inquiry has been conducted by the S.H.O., Police Station Women, Police Lines, Amritsar to the effect that no cognizable offence is found to have been committed by respondents No.4 to 8. A copy of the inquiry report has been sent in the whatsapp group.

Faced with the aforesaid situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail legal remedies available to the petitioner in accordance with law.
