AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Today physical hearing was held but on request of learned counsel for the petitioner, the matter is taken up for hearing by way of hybrid hearing.

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 114 dated 26.6.2021, under Sections 457, 380 and 411 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhattu Kalan, District Fatehabad.

The allegations are that the petitioner along with co-accused had stolen fourteen bags of mustard and eight bags of wheat from the porch of farm house of the complainant. The petitioner was apprehended and recovery of six bags of mustard was made.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 26.8.2021. No further recovery is to be made from him.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for grant of regular bail. She submits that the co-accused is yet to be arrested.

Considering the facts and circumstances in totality, especially the fact that the conclusion of investigation and trial is likely to take time, the petitioner is granted bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the

satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
