1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.292 dated 23.08.2020, registered under Sections 363, 366-A to which Section 120-B IPC was added later on at Police Station Bawal, District Rewari.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 23.11.2020, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated in the same, was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned DAG, Haryana, on instructions from *SI Dharamvir*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 23.11.2020, the petitioner joined investigation, cooperated in the same, was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the statement of learned DAG, Haryana, order 23.11.2020 passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
6. Petition stands ***disposed of*** in the aforementioned terms.
