The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the official respondents to give 50% of the salary of the deceased-Sonu to the petitioner as after his death, his wife is getting the salary in her account and the petitioners/parents are having no source of income as they are fully dependent upon their sole son as well as 50% of all the financial/monetary benefits, for which, legal

notice dated 28.08.2021 (Annexure P-7) has also been served upon the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider legal notice dated 28.08.2021 (Annexure P-7) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
