The matter has been taken up through the medium of video conferencing.

The present criminal writ petition has been preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus seeking the release of detenue, namely, Priya daughter of Baljinder Singh from the clutches of respondent No.4, namely, Anmoldeep Singh son of Prempal Singh.

A perusal of the case file shows that the present petition came up for filing on 11.07.2019 with the allegation that the daughter of petitioner, namely, Priya had gone for examination but did not return thereafter. Later on, the petitioner came to know that her daughter, namely, Priya had sought protection to her life and liberty before this Court vide CRM-M-11583 of 2019, which was disposed of vide order dated 13.03.2019.

Notice of motion was issued in the present case for 16.07.2019 vide an order dated 12.07.2019 and thereafter, the respondents No.4 to 8 were found to be not served and fresh notices were issued again for 14.08.2019 and since then, the petitioner is not appearing consistently, and today again, no one has put in appearance on her behalf.

After having perused the facts of the present case, pleadings made out in the petition itself and the earlier orders passed by the Court, I am of the considered view that the petitioner does not seem to be interested in pursuing the present petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
