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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 52 dated 27.4.2021 registered under Sections 15, 25, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala.

The case was registered on the secret information that petitioner alongwith co accused Gurjit Singh, Kanwaljit Singh alias Kamal and Jaspal were involved in selling of poppy husk. A naka was laid and 3 cars were intercepted i.e. Verna car, I-10 car and Toyota Etios car. From Verna car, 6 bags of poppy husk weighing 25 kg each were recovered. From I-10 car, 1 bag of poppy husk weighing 25 kg was recovered. Petitioner and Gurjit Singh who were occupants of this car were arrested. The Toyota Etios car was driven by Jaspal Singh who was its owner and co passenger was Manjinder Singh. 1 bag containing 25 kg. Poppy husk was recovered.

Learned counsel for petitioner states that recovery from petitioner is non commercial. He cannot be said to be in conscious possession of poppy husk recovered from other cars. The petitioner is in custody since 27.4.2021. The investigation in case is complete.

In view thereof, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars. Hence, petition is allowed. Petitioner Inderjeet Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned. However, if petitioner indulges in any activity of similar nature, while on bail, prosecution agency will be at liberty to seek cancellation of order granting bail to petitioner.
