This writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No.2 and 4 to take physical possession of the mortgaged property and hand over the same to the petitioner-bank in compliance of the order dated 31.1.2014 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2 under Section 14 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act 2002.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that an extension has been granted to the respondent No.5 (A,B,C and D) to clear the entire amount up to 25th March, 2021 as per the OTS Scheme and prays that the instant petition may be disposed of as infructuous.
