This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing official respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of respondents No.5 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 13.09.2021 to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Jind, District Jind, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/2, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Amit Aggarwal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Jind, District Jind, to look into and decide representation dated 13.09.2021 (Annexure P/2) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
