The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.255 dated 19.06.2019, registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC and subsequently added Sections 419, 467, 468, 370, 120-B IPC, Section 24 of Emigration Act, 1983 and Section 12 of The Passports Act, 1967, registered at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala

The operative part of the order dated 26.10.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...It is inter alia contended that name of the petitioner does not even figure in the FIR and the complainant has not levelled any allegations against him. Main accused Surinder Singh alias Chhinda has been granted interim bail by this Court as the matter is stated to have been settled with the complainant.

Notice of motion, returnable for 12.01.2021....”

CASE HEARD THROUGH VIDEO CONFERENCING

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 26.10.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector Sunil Kumar, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 26.10.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
