Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to decide his representation dated 23.08.2021 (Annexure P-14) as soon as possible, keeping in view his current medical condition.

2. Learned State counsel, on advance service, joins proceedings and submits that the writ petition has been filed pre-maturely as admittedly, the representation filed by the petitioner is pending before the competent authority and the same shall be decided, either way, in due course.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let a final decision is taken, either way, by the competent authority on the pending representation dated 23.08.2021 (Annexure P-14), giving reasons thereof.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per representation dated 23.08.2021 (Annexure

P-14) and also by keeping in view the contention raised in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and take a decision, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done as expeditiously as possible but not later than 2 months from today.

7. Disposed of accordingly.
