The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.102 dated 08.07.2020 registered under Section 295-A IPC and under Section 4A, 4B of The Punjab Prohibition of Cow Slaughter Act at Police Station City-I Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

On 16.10.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

“The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR. He has been nominated in the disclosure statement of co-accused, who were arrested in FIR No. 156 dated 11.7.2020 under Sections 399, 402 IPC registered at Police Station Amargarh. Learned counsel further submits that ingredients of offence under Section 295-A IPC and Sections 4-A and 4-B of the Punjab Prohibition of Cow Slaughter Act are not attracted.

Notice of motion for 1.12.2020.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 20.10.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ram Singh submits that in compliance of order dated 16.10.2020, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and he is no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 16.10.2020 is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the

investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer.
