The petitioners have invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for quashing the order/letter dated 17.12.2018 (P-2), 17.12.2018 (P-3) and 18.01.2019 (P-4) vide which the alleged overpayment of GIS final payment has been recovered from the account of the petitioners in illegal and arbitrary manner and also contrary to the judgments passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court as followed by the Hon'ble High Court.
