The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuing a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of the alleged detainee namely Karandeep @ Karan Dhiman.

On 13.09.2021, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had appointed a Warrant Officer and had directed him to submit a report.

The Warrant Officer has submitted a detailed report in which it has been stated that in fact FIR bearing No. 139 dated 09.09.2021 under Sections 363, 366A IPC was registered against the said Karandeep @ Karan Dhiman on the complaint of Sh. Rohit Sharma S/o Sh. Rakesh Kumar and in the said case, he was arrested by the Investigation Officer on 12.09.2021 vide General Diary No. 24 dated 12.09.2021 and was produced in the concerned Court on 13.09.2021 and had been remanded in police custody for one day.

Learned counsel appearing for Poonam Devi W/o Rakesh Kumar-respondent No. 4 has submitted that the allegations against respondent No. 4 are absolutely false inasmuch respondent No. 4 had died on 18.07.2018.

In view of the abovesaid facts and circumstances, moreso the report submitted by the Warrant Officer, it is apparent the the present case is not a case of illegal detention as Karandeep @ Karan Dhiman was arrested in an FIR registered against him.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
