The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.66 dated 19.07.2020 registered under Sections 452/323/148 read with Section 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC is added later on) at Police Station Amir Khas, District Fazilka.

Notice of motion was issued on 16.10.2020, after noticing the fact that as per allegation in the FIR, the petitioners only entered into the house of the complainant but no injury was attributed to the petitioners. Petitioners along with co-accused Deepu and Baggi allegedly trespassed into the house of the complainant. Deepu allegedly gave a sword blow on the head of Paramjeet Singh son of the complainant and Baggi also allegedly gave blow from reserve side of kaapa on his teeth. The aforesaid co-accused namely Deepu and Baggi have been

granted regular bail by the Court of Sessions. While issuing notice of motion, presence of concerned SHO and Investigating Officer was required and they were directed to remain present in the Court through video conferencing.

Today ASI Mahinder Singh and SHO are present through video conferencing.

Mr. Ramandeep Sandhu, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab has also identified them to be the same persons whose presence was required vide order dated 16.10.2020.

Learned State counsel on instructions from the aforesaid officers submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 16.10.2020 is made absolute. Petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
