Petitioner-Paramjit Singh stated to be aged 47 years, has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with the prayer for directing the respondent-corporation not to effect recovery from the salary of the petitioner pending the application for stay made by the petitioner in the statutory appeal dated 06.08.2021 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon orders dated 23.05.2018, 05.05.2021, 18.12.2020, 03.12.2020 and 28.01.2021 (Annexures P-4 to P-8) passed by this Court.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rahul Sachdeva, Advocate puts in appearance for the respondents and he has no objection in case the writ

petition is disposed of in the same terms as order dated 28.01.2021 passed in

CWP-1917-2021 titled as “Jasvir Singh Vs. Managing Director, The Punjab State Cooperative Supply & Marketing Federation Limited & Ors.”

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, this writ petition is *disposed of* with a direction to the appellate authority to decide statutory appeal within the *six months* from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and till then recovery from the salary of the petitioner shall not be effected.
