The petitioners have filed this petition for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the letter dated 24.03.2020 (Annexure P-6) whereby fresh condition of experience of particular three years (2016-17, 2017-18 and 2018-19) has been imposed after closing date for submitting the tenders.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that to redress their grievances, the petitioners have already filed objections dated 02.04.2020 (Annexure P-9) and also served legal notices dated 07.04.2020 and 27.04.2020 (Annexures P-10 and P-14) before the respondent authorities but no decision thereon has been taken as yet.

Learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Haryana submits that the respondent-authorities shall consider and take a decision on the aforesaid objections/legal notices (Annexures P-9, P-10 and P-14) filed by the petitioners within a period of two weeks and decision thereof would be communicated to the petitioners.

In view of the aforesaid statement/undertaking made by learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, the petition stands disposed of.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and therefore, the respondent-authorities would be at liberty to examine the matter keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter accept or reject the same in accordance with law.
