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RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (oral)

This petition has been filed by the petitioner-association raising an issue regarding implementation of the recommendations made by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Traffic & Security, Chandigarh, vide letter dated 28.06.2019, as well as for taking steps in respect of the traffic congestion being caused by the persons by blocking roads by undertaking certain activities thereon.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-Union Territory, Chandigarh as well as Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh submit that the recommendations made by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Traffic & Security, Chandigarh vide letter dated 28.06.2019, were forwarded to the Chief Architect, Chandigarh, who has considered and rejected the same, as those cannot be implemented on account of various factors.

As far as the second issue raised by the petitioner-association regarding encroachments and blocking of roads by the persons undertaking certain activities thereon, is concerned, learned counsel appearing for the respondent-Union Territory, Chandigarh as well as Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh submit that the aforesaid aspect shall be looked into by the respondent-authorities and the necessary steps as required by law shall be taken by them expeditiously.

In view of the aforesaid statements made by learned counsel for the respondents, the petition stands disposed of.
