The instant petition is for quashing of FIR No. 241, dated 23.08.2020, lodged under Section 376 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise dated 24.09.2020 (Annexure P-3) arrived at, between the parties.

It has been submitted that subsequent to the registration of the FIR, which was registered on account of some misunderstanding between the parties, who admittedly are major, the parties had solemnized their marriage on 20th September, 2020, as their differences had been ironed out and misunderstandings removed. Subsequently, compromise dated 24th September, 2020 was effected between the parties.

On a pointed query, learned counsel appearing for the parties have apprised the Court that the matter is still under investigation and the challan is yet to be presented by the Investigating Agency.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material on record. However, when this Court was not inclined to invoke its inherent jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR in question, a prayer was made by learned counsel for the parties that they be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to get their respective statements recorded before the Investigating Agency *qua* the matter having been amicably resolved between the parties as also the factum of the parties having solemnized marriage on 20th September, 2020.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
