Vide this application directions have been sought for recording of statements of the parties before the Court below, which has already directed vide order dated 16.02.2021, as such no further order needs to be passed in the present application.

In this petition, the petitioners, who are accused persons in F.I.R No.64, dated 14.06.2019, under Sections 379, 427, 447, 511, 506, 148 & 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Haryana, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1), have prayed for quashing of F.I.R. with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

2. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide Compromise (Annexure

P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The Ld. Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Hoshiarpur, vide report dated 16.04.2021 has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

3. Respondent Nos.2 to 5 are represented by their Counsel who does not dispute the factum of compromise.

4. In view of the report of the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Hoshiarpur, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **“Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **“Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466**, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the Respondent Nos.2 to 5 have themselves compromised the dispute with the accused persons.

5. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. F.I.R No.64, dated 14.06.2019, under Sections 379, 427, 447, 511, 506, 148 & 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Hariana, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed *qua* the present petitioners.
