Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.312 dated 08.08.2021 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 22.09.2021: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR was registered on the statement of victim Yudhishtar with the allegations that on 07.08.2021, he had gone to a hotel of his friend Avtar Singh for collecting money, where Avtar Singh asked him to go after taking lunch. In the meantime, his another friend Rajat (petitioner) also came there in a car and kept waiting in his car. When the victim, after having his lunch, was passing by the car of

Rajat, he attacked him with a sword. When the victim tried to stop the sword blow, it hit on the thumb of his left hand. Thereafter, petitioner again gave sword blow, which hit on the palm of the right hand of the victim. In the meantime, some people gathered there and petitioner Rajat ran away from the spot. The victim was shifted to Astha Hospital, Sirsa by his friend Avtar Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that without any prejudice to the right of defence of the petitioner, he is ready to compensate the victim by paying him a sum of Rs.25,000/- towards his medical expenses...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Banwar Lal, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 22.09.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
