Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioners pray for quashing of FIR No.104, dated 14.09.2017, registered under Sections 406/120 IPC, at Police Station Phase-11, Mohali, on the ground that a bare reading of the said FIR shows that no offence is made out therein.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to take all issues raised in the present petition through a detailed representation to be made to respondent No.3.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

In case, the representation, the liberty of which is sought and got through the instant order, is made by the petitioners to respondent No.3, respondent No.3 shall personally consider the same after hearing the petitioners and only then authorise filing of a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.
