The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 65 dated 22.05.2020, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the IPC at Police Station Bhaini Mian Khan, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to order dated 23.11.2020, the petitioner has joined investigation and has also deposited Rs. 1 Lakh by way of RTGS in favour of complainant Rajenderpal Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that as on today, the petitioner has paid a sum of Rs. 9 Lakh (approx.) and he will make the balance payment by way of Rs. 50,000/- per month starting from

01.04.2021.

This offer is accepted by learned counsel for the complainant, however, it is submitted that in case of default of payment by the petitioner, a liberty may be granted to complainant to revive the present petition.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, without making any comment on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order dated 23.11.2020, granting interim bail to petitioner, is made absolute, subject to conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, this will be subject to a condition that petitioner will make the payment of balance amount by way of paying Rs. 50,000/- per month starting from 01.04.2021.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner defaults in making aforesaid payments, respondent-2/complainant will be at liberty to revive this petition.
