The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondent authorities to immediately release the retiral benefits of the petitioner including gratuity and fully family pension from the due date of superannuation i.e. 30.04.2005 which has wrongly been withheld alongwith interest @ 12% per annum, for which, representation dated 04.08.2021 (Annexure P-8) has also been

submitted before the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider representation dated 04.08.2021 (Annexure P-8) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
