Affidavit of District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner,
Ropar dated 25.10.2021 has been filed which is taken on record.

Since nobody has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner and the position was same on the last date of hearing as well, therefore, this Court will proceed in the present case in the absence of learned counsel for the petitioner.

The present petition has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for appointing the warrant officer for the release or produce the detenues detailed in para No.4 of the petition.

The learned State counsel while referring to the affidavit filed by the District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Ropar has submitted that a team consisting of 4 members i.e. DSP, (Rupnagar), Tehsildar (Rupnagar), Assistant Food Supply Officer, (Rupnagar) and Labour Inspector (Rupnagar) was constituted on 16.9.2021

with the direction to personally visit the site/spot and to submit its report. The said team had visited the brick kiln but did not find any detenue as mentioned in para No.4 of the writ petition. Even no illegality or irregularity of any kind had been found by the aforesaid team at the spot and common statement of some labour persons mentioned in the writ was also recorded and they had stated that they had come to work on this brick kiln but they felt that this type of clay and atmosphere is not suitable to them, they will be returning back to their original village in U.P. on their own sweet will and there are no dues towards the brick kiln Managers and that no person of the labour was beaten up by the brick kiln owner.

In view of the affidavit filed by the District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Ropar that no detenue was detected on the brick kiln mentioned in the writ petition, nothing survives in the present petition.

Consequently, the writ petition is, hereby, dismissed.
