The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 18 dated 01.03.2020, under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Kiratpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that 250 grams of 'charas' (non-commercial quantity) was allegedly recovered from the petitioner. He had been granted regular bail by the trial Court and was appearing before the Court on each and every date of hearing. He, however, could not appear on 13.07.2021 due to communication gap about the date of hearing with his counsel. He undertakes that the petitioner shall henceforth appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing and would not absent himself except with prior permission of the Court.

This Court, by the order dated 20.09.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate and he was to be released on ad-interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has appeared before the trial court and he was admitted to ad interim bail.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner having submitted his bail bonds, the order dated 20.09.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on each and every date.

The petition stands disposed of.
