By this petition, quashing of FIR No.46, dated 09.06.2015, is sought, registered at Police Station Ajitwala, District Moga, for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 324 of the IPC, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioner (accused) and respondent no.2, i.e. the complainant.

Pursuant to the order dated 26.10.2020, the report of the learned JMIC, Moga, dated 03.12.2020, has been received, stating to the effect that the statements of the parties, including the complainant in the FIR, i.e. respondent no.2 Kulwant Singh, were recorded to that effect, with the petitioner also not found to have been declared to be a proclaimed offender as per the investigating officer.

As per the assessment of that court, the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and voluntarily.

That being so, looking at the nature of the offence, the petition is allowed, with FIR No.46, dated 09.06.2015, registered at Police Station Ajitwala, District Moga, for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 324 of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
