The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short, "the Cr.P.C.") for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.29 dated 11.06.2018 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 14 of the Foreigners Act, 1946 at Police Station STF Phase 4, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Custody certificate has been filed by the learned State Counsel in Court today which is taken on record.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that the prosecution evidence has been concluded in the case and even statement of the petitioner under Section 313 of the Cr.P.C. has been recorded and the case is fixed for defence evidence.

After arguing for some time and highlighting delay in conclusion of the trial, learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner does not want to continue with the present petition

and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn at this stage but the trial Court may be directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

However, in view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial and dispose of the case expeditiously preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

A copy of this order be sent to the trial Court concerned for requisite compliance.
