Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 231 dated 03.12.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 341, 379B, 427, 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sanoli, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner had snatched a mobile phone and `700/- from the complainant after beating him up and damaging his car. He also contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted regular bail by the trial Court, but he could not appear before the Court on 27.05.2021, as he was under the impression that only urgent cases would be taken up. Consequently, his bail was cancelled. He undertakes that the petitioner shall henceforth appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing and would not absent himself except with prior permission of the Court.

This court, by the order dated 17.09.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and he was to be released on ad-interim bail to its satisfaction.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 21.09.2021 in terms of the previous order of this Court and has been granted *ad interim* bail.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having appeared before the trial Court, the order dated 17.09.2021 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
