HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking a direction from this Court to protect her life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 5 to 8.

It is averred in the petition that the petitioner has been cheated to the tune of Rs.30 lacs by the private respondents in order to send her son to Canada. It is also averred in the petition that the petitioner has already filed a complaint raising the said grievance and now, the petitioner is being pressurized to withdraw the said complaint by the private respondents and is being threatened as well.

From the perusal of para 9 of this petition, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 06.08.2021 (Annexure P-5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga (though wrongly typed as SSP, Mansa in Annexure P-5) , which is stated to be pending with the said authority.

The interest of justice will be served, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the representation of the petitioner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the representation dated 06.08.2021 (Annexure P-5) will be decided by respondent No.3 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 06.08.2021 (Annexure P-5), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 06.08.2021 (Annexure P-5) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
