Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.135 dated 20.08.2021, under Sections 451 and 354 of IPC, registered at Police Station Vairoke, Disttict Fazilka.

By virtue of the order dated 16.09.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Radhey Sham has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.
