Main Case

This Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 (1) (c) (d) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988, has been moved by petitioner for release of petitioner on two weeks parole for treatment of his ailing wife, in case FIR No.88 dated 17.06.2003 under Section 20 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Loharu, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that grievance of the petitioner would be redressed in case the instant petition is treated as representation on behalf of the petitioner and if the same is ordered to be disposed of by respondent No.3-Superintendent, Central Jail, Bhondsi, Gurugram, in a time bound manner.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Amit Aggarwal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent, Central Jail, Bhondsi, Gurugram, to treat the instant petition as representation and to look into and decide the same in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within ten (10) days positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
