The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.318 dated 21.11.2018, registered under Sections 307/34 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Julana, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since in the petitioner's trial only 07 prosecution witnesses remain to be examined, at this stage, he does not press the present petition on its merits and he would be satisfied if directions are issued to the Trial Court for expeditious disposal of the petitioner's trial.

Learned State counsel has no objection if the above prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted.

In the light of the above and because the petitioner is in custody for about 02 years and 11 months as also because every under trial has a right to a speedy trial, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to

the State to produce all the remaining 07 prosecution witnesses within six weeks from the date next fixed before the Trial Court which in turn is directed to make every endeavor to examine them on their production by the State. The petitioner's trial shall thereafter be finally adjudicated upon by the Trial Court within six weeks, in accordance with law.
