The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the amount of pertaining to Group Insurance Scheme, leave encashment, gratuity and other admissible emoluments, if any, along with interest @ 18% pertaining to the deceased son of petitioner namely Ranjan Kumar Puri Son of Sat Pal Puri, who had been working with respondent No.2 as Patwari and had expired on 01.05.1990.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.
