The petitioners in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seek directions to the respondents to release the amount of LTC for the Block Years 2016-2019 in the case of petitioner no. 1 and for petitioner no. 2 for block years 2016-19 and 2020-23 alongwith interest. Thus, mandamus is sought to decide the legal notice dated 18.05.2021 (Annexure P-9).

Counsel, at the outset, submits that sanction has been granted for the necessary purpose in the case of petitioner no. 1 way back on 03.06.2019 (Annexure P-6) by respondent no. 4 and in the case of petitioner no. 2, on 22.08.2019 and 30.12.2020 (Annexures P-7 and P-8) but in spite of that payment has not been made. Counsel further submits that he would be satisfied if the legal notice dated 18.05.2021 (Annexure P-9) is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Kumar Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on
behalf of the respondents.

Keeping in view the limited controversy as such and since the decision making is still incomplete, no useful purpose will be served to call upon the respondents for filing reply, as it would cause inordinate delay in deciding the proceedings.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to respondents to take a decision on the legal notice dated 18.05.2021 (Annexure P-9) within a period of 4 weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case the petitioners are held entitled for the relief sought, payment be made immediately thereafter. In case there is any legal impediment and the relief is to be denied, speaking order be passed and communicated to the petitioners forthwith.
