By this petition, filed under the provisions of Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family.

That being so, without commenting on the merits of the petition, this petition is disposed of. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, is directed to go into the grievance of the petitioner after hearing both sides and to take a decision as may be warranted as per law within a

period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The petitioner would be free to produce the photographs, (Annexure P-2) as also the documents which he wishes to produce, before the Senior Superintendent of Police.
