GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to handover the investigation pertaining to FIR No.649 dated 01.11.2019 registered at Police Station Faridabad Central, District Faridabad, under Sections 120-B/420/467/468/471 IPC to some senior IPS Officer so as to initiate proper legal action against respondents No.7 & 8.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had been working with M/s Himgiri Auto India Pvt. Ltd., Faridabad as a Manager Fleet Sales and that the instant FIR had been lodged at his instance against respondents No.7 & 8, when it came to his notice that they had prepared forged registration certificates in respect of some of the vehicles sold by M/s Himgiri Auto India Pvt. Ltd.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the officials of the Regional Transport Authority, Faridabad are somehow all out to help the accused and some of the police officials have also connived with them and that the matter is not being properly investigated and in fact the accused even after the registration of the case have committed several other identical offences as have also been mentioned in representation dated 10.2.2021 (Annexure P-7).
4. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards veracity of the averments made in the petition, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – the Commissioner of Police, Faridabad to ensure that the matter pertaining to FIR No.649 dated 01.11.2019 is got investigated expeditiously in accordance with law and that the investigation is also monitored by some officer of cadre of IPS. It is further ordered that the allegations levelled in the representation dated 10.02.2021 (Annexure P-7) shall also be examined during the course of investigation.
5. A copy of this order along with copy of the representation (Annexure P-7) be sent to respondent No.3 – the Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, for necessary compliance.
