The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for quashing impugned orders dated 27.02.2018 (Annexure P-10) and dated 24.04.2018 (Annexure P-6) with further prayer to direct the respondents to reconsider the case of the petitioner for re-fixation of pension and release of arrears of salary and other service

benefits/allowances, for which, legal notice dated 22.06.2021 (Annexure P-14) has also been served upon the respondent authorities.

Heard. Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court Ms. Simran Grewal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let copy of the paper book be supplied to her.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 22.06.2021 (Annexure P-14) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
