The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to fill up all the existing vacancies in the Primary Health Centre (PHC), Balu, Tehsil Kalayat, District Kaithal and in the District Civil Hospital, Kaithal as reflected in vacancy status Annexures P-1 to P-3, with a further prayer to direct the respondents to provide complete healthcare facilities in the PHC, Balu; and also with certain other prayers.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

While referring to the written statement filed by the respondents No.2 & 3, through its Civil Surgeon, it has been submitted by the counsel for the State, that the necessary postings have already been made at PHC in village Balu, Tehsil Kalayat, District Kaithal and the other hospitals mentioned in the petition. The orders have also been issued to engage the necessary staff through outsourcing. Still further, it is submitted that best efforts are being made to ensure that no vacancy is left to be filled up in these hospitals.

In view of the above, and there being no further assistance from the side of the petitioners, this court does not deem it appropriate to continue with the present petition any more.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
