Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing, on the basis of a compromise arrived at them and respondent no. 2, of FIR no. 176 dated 20.05.2018, registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 341/323/324/506/34 of the IPC (with Section 201 of the IPC having been added later), as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom. A copy of the compromise deed has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition.

Pursuant to the order dated 26.10.2020, a report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, dated 25.01.2021, has been received, stating therein that the statements of the complainant, Major Singh (respondent no. 2), as also of the accused, i.e. the three petitioners therein, were recorded by that court on 24.11.2020, with all of them having

unanimously stated that they had compromised the matter between them and had no objection if the proceedings are quashed.

The statement of ASI Jagdev Singh was also recorded to the effect that none of the accused are proclaimed offenders.

As per the assessment of that court the compromise arrived at is made of the own free will of the parties and not under any pressure or undue influence.

That being so, with the statement of the complainant also having been annexed with the report and learned counsel appearing for him today reiterating his commitment to the compromise reached, as also looking at the nature of offences involved, with the matter having been amicably settled between the parties, the petition is allowed and FIR no. 176 dated 20.05.2018, registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 341/323/324/506/34 of the IPC (with Section 201 of the IPC having been added later), along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
