Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that a fraud has been played upon the petitioner by private respondents No. 4 to 7 and in the said fraud, the petitioner has lost her gold ornaments along with money. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already filed number of representations for the enquiry into the allegations of the said fraud, wherein the petitioner had suffered financially as well as mentally but no action is being taken by the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the latest representation, which has been filed by the petitioner is dated 29.04.2021 (Annexure P-5), which is still pending consideration with respondent No. 2 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation dated 29.04.2021 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner by

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned State counsel raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 29.04.2021 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 29.04.2021 (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It will be appreciated if the private respondents are also associated before passing the speaking order.

Present petition stands disposed of.
