[1] Learned State counsel has produced communication dated 22.12.2021 from the Haryana Staff Selection Commission to the Director General of Police, Haryana recommending appointment of the petitioner as Male Constable (General Duty) after verification of the record and antecedents. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

[2] After perusal of the recommendation, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of by directing the respondents to take a decision on the claim of the petitioner in terms of the recommendation as made by the Haryana Staff Selection Commission vide its letter dated 22.12.2021 in a time bound manner.

[3] Learned State counsel states that formalities would be got completed and action taken on the recommendation within a period of six weeks.

[5] Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to take steps to complete formalities and to take follow up action on the recommendation received by the office of the DGP from the Haryana Staff Selection Commission with regard to the joining of the petitioner in accordance with law within six weeks from today.
