The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners by way of instant writ petition are seeking directions against the respondents to pay interest @ 12% on the delayed payment of GPF, gratuity, leave encashment and delay in payment of pension.

Counsel for the petitioner Mr. Vikas Singh submits that the petitioners had already made representation dated 21.06.2021 (Annexure P-7) which was summarily disposed off by the respondents without passing any speaking order.

Heard.

Be so as it may, the present petition is disposed off with the directions to the respondents to duly consider the representation dated 21.06.2021 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioners in accordance with law and to pass a detailed speaking order enumerating reasons therein, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioners are held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay as per law.
