The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.202 dated 30.9.2020 registered under Sections 498-A I.P.C (Section 406 IPC was added later on) at Police Station, City-1, Sangrur, District Sangrur.

By virtue of the order dated 27.10.2020, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 27.10.2020, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute. Counsel further submits that parties were referred to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court, however, the proceedings remained unsuccessful and parties could not reach to any amicable settlement.

Report of the Mediator affirms the above position.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Nirbhai Singh, has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for

further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the prayer made by counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 27.10.2020 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
