Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioners for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of respondents No.3 and 4 and further protection from implication of petitioners in false criminal case at the hands of respondents No.3 and 4 on the instigation of private respondents No.5 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation on 12.09.2021 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/4, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 and 2 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Mr. J.S. Toor, Additional Public Prosecutor, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2. Complete copies of paper book has been supplied to them.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, to look into and decide representation dated 12.09.2021 (Annexure P/4) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
