1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 11.08.2021, Annexure P/2 dated 08.09.2021 passed by the learned Addl. District Judge, Chandigarh and Annexure P/3 dated 26.08.2021, passed by this Court, in FAO-852/2021.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that after the filing of the contempt petition, the petitioner has been supplied copy of order dated 16.09.2021, passed by the respondent in compliance with the orders as referred to above, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.
