Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.125 dated 14.09.2020 under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar Rural.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 02.12.2020: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that without any prejudice to petitioner’s right of defence, he is ready to deposit an amount of Rs.5,00,000/- with the Illaqua

Magistrate, subject to final outcome of the case...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation and amount of Rs.5.00 lacs stands deposited with the Illaqa Magistrate.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Tarlok Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 02.12.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

As requested by learned counsel for the complainant, the complainant is permitted to withdraw the aforesaid amount of Rs.5.00 lacs on furnishing adequate security to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate.
