This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 309 dated 22.11.2019 under Sections 22 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act registered at Police Station City Rajpura District Patiala.

As per allegations, petitioner has been implicated solely on the ground of his mobile number appearing on the courier, which was delivered to the office of M/s Ahuja Medical Store. In fact, petitioner is not working in the office of M/s Ahuja Medical Store, rather he is working in the office of M/s Guru Nanak Medical Hall. Petitioner in any case is not the beneficiary

of such consignment.

Vide order dated 21.12.2020, petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagminder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and he is not required in any further investigation of the case.

In view of above interim order dated 21.12.2020 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
