This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the notices dated 9.7.2021 (Annexures P-8 and P-9), vide which respondent No. 4 directed the petitioners to deposit the amount/stamp duty as per Section 47-A (3) of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899. It is further prayed that the recovery of amount/stamp duty from the petitioner be stayed during the pendency of the present petition.

A perusal of the paper book show that the petitioners have approached this Court at the stage of grant of opportunity of hearing only. Hence, the present petition is pre-mature.

Dismissed as such.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to approach the Court again; in case they feel aggrieved against the order passed by the authorities.
