Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.374 dated 21.06.2019 registered under Sections 406, 420, 468, 471 and 506 IPC at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

Vide order dated 19.07.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 19.07.2019 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner had already joined the investigation.

On 25.09.2019, learned State counsel, on the instructions

from SI Surender Kumar, submitted that the petitioner had joined the investigation.

Today, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is now not required for any further investigation.

On the previous two dates, learned counsel for the complainant requested for an adjournment to place on record the certain documents. However, no document has been filed.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 19.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
