The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to re-fix the basic pay of petitioner in the pay scale of Rs.14590/- + 3200/- grade pay per month w.e.f. 01.01.2006 in the revised pay scale equal/higher to the basic pay drawn by his Junior (Performa Respondent) and further to revise the basic pay of the petitioner upto his date of retirement i.e. 31.01.2016 and to draw the revised pay of the petitioner from 01.01.2006 onwards along with other admissible benefits, arrears of pay along with interest @ 12%

per annum and also to revise the pension of the petitioner accordingly.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Ms. Simran Grewal, AAG, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State. Copy supplied.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 10.08.2021 (Annexure P-6) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
